



Music up. Intro card.

Track 1) Taking the PSAT 8/9 in eighth or ninth grade...




Cursor clicks on URL.

Track 3) ...but can also help you to plan for high school and college.




Score Report card appears.

Track 5) In addition to your detailed test scores for the PSAT 8/9...




Intro card slides off screen. Line emerges that connects one card to the next.


Username and Password fields fill in. Cursor clicks on "Sign In" button.


Camera focuses on right side of card. Cursor clicks on Arrow button.


Section Scores card appears. Score elements animate in.




















